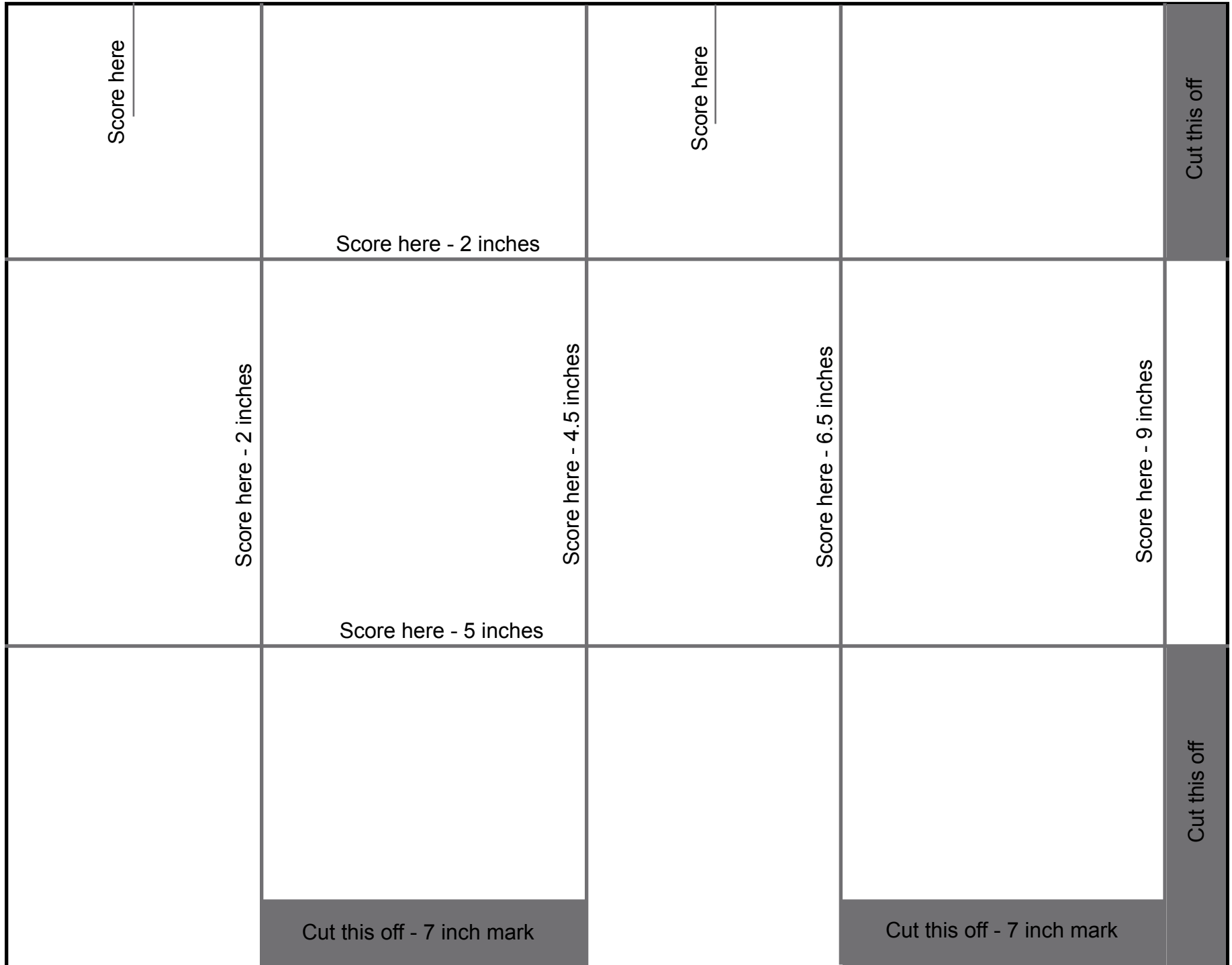


Kisses Box Template

Kisses Box Template - Directions and Tip Sheet

Directions:

1. Cut a piece of card stock or acetate to 7.5" x 9.5"
2. Stamp first if desired. The scored cardstock is harder to stamp because it doesn't lay flat.
3. On the 9.5 inch length, score at 2 inches, 4.5 inches, 6.5 inches and 9 inches.
4. Turn paper and score 2 inches and at 5 inches.
5. Trim the wider panels on the bottom down to 2 inches as shown.
6. Trim the .5 inch pieces off as shown.
7. If desired, score 2 inch top panels down the middle to make the top fold easier.
8. Fold on all scores.
9. Place adhesive on the .5 panel.
10. You now have two bottom panels that are longer. Fold the 2.5 inch length side opposite the tabbed .5 side panel in first. Fold in a 2 inch panel, then the 2.5 inch panel with the tab, then the last 2 inch panel. Press the tab and side of the box together.
11. Adhese the bottom tabbed panel to the bottom of the other panel.
12. Put Hershey Kisses or 6-8 Ghiradelli chocolates squares in the box.
13. Fold in the scored top panel like a milk carton. Take any hole punch and punch two holes in through on both pinched sides.
14. Thread ribbon through and tie.
15. Embellish box as desired.
16. You're done!
